Volcanoes & Earthquakes

- Our Earth is made up of the inner core, outer core, mantle and crust.
- The Earth's crust is made up of large areas called tectonic plates that meet.
- When the tectonic plates move, it causes friction. This causes earthquakes and volcanic eruptions near the edges of the plates.
- An earthquake is a sudden violent shaking of the ground.
- A volcano is made when pressure builds up inside the Earth. This opens the Earth's crust causing magma to sometimes erupt through it.
- There are three different types of volcano: active (erupted in the last 10 000 years), dormant (haven't erupted in the last 10 000 years) and extinct (are not expected to erupt again).
