Materials - Changes	<ul> <li>Sieving is where small and large materials can be separated by allowing the smaller ones to fall through the holes in the sieve.</li> <li>Filtering is where the solid particles get caught in the filter, but the liquid moves through it.</li> <li>Solubility is where something can be dissolved in water.</li> <li>Evaporating is where the liquid changes into a gas leaving the solid part behind.</li> <li>Some changes are reversible – meaning they can go back again such as ice and water.</li> <li>Some changes are irreversible because they form a new material – for example burning wood produces a new substance ash.</li> </ul>
