Drawing

- Pencils are graded by numbers are used to tell us how soft the lead is. The higher the number the softer the lead and the darker the mark.

Spring 1

Painting

- Shade is a darker version of a colour.
- Tint is a lighter version of a colour.
- Complimentary colours sit across from each other on the colour wheel.

Summer 1

Sculpture

- If you 'pinch clay' you use your thumb and finger to shape the clay.
- 'Coiling' means to spiral the clay in an upward motion to form a shape.
- Carving means to use tools to scrape away parts of the clay.
