Dear Crackley Bank Families,

It's about that time again when we celebrate Harvest in school! Last year, our harvest collection was such a success that we would like to do it again this year and create/continue our 'Crackley Food Bank' as a way of supporting our families who may need it.

We have asked staff in school, and are asking families who feel they are able to, to contribute donations of food and toiletries. We request that these are brought into school no later than <u>Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September</u> so the children can see our collection in full before adding to our Food Bank table. We will then be opening the 'Crackley Food Bank' the following week in our school office next to Mrs Gleaves office. We will set up a table with any donated items, and ask Crackley Bank families who require it to come and help themselves free of charge. We are hoping to continue this throughout the year, so if at any point you would like to donate any more items, please just drop them into us.

We request that any donations be items which can stay out without refrigeration, or long-lasting items such as:

- Tinned cold meat ham, pork, corned beef, tinned items such as beans, spaghetti, vegetables etc.
- Tinned fruit
- Tea/coffee/sugar
- Cereals, porridge, breakfast bars
- Soup, pasta, rice
- Tinned tomato/pasta sauces
- Long life milk & long-life juice (orange/apple etc)
- Sponge puddings, chocolate, sweets etc.
- Toilet rolls, kitchen rolls, tissues.
- Shampoo, shower gel, deodorants, shaving gel and foam, sanitary items, soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes.
- Washing powder, tablets, pods, washing up liquid.

Thank you for your continued support, but **please** don't feel you need to give if you are unable to do so. It is far more important to keep yourselves well stocked up with the things you need.
