PE is on Mondays

On Mondays, children should arrive to school wearing their PE kit. PE kit should be a plain white or plain team colour top (ask us if you're unsure what team your child is in), plain jogging bottoms or shorts and sensible trainers.

or cover them with plasters. In order to
take part, all earrings must be removed
before coming to school.

Don't forget to label your jumper, coats and water bottles in case they decide to wander off!

Important: Water bottles need to be washed and bought back into school filled up every day.
