Autumn 1	
Drawing	 Third dimension means making an object look solid by using drawing techniques. Perspective is to make a drawing appear 3D on a 2D plain. E.g. A road appearing to curve in the distance or an apple sitting on a table.
Spring 1	
Painting	 Tone is how light or dark a colour is. Shade is a darker version of a colour. Complimentary colours sit opposite each other on the colour wheel.
Summer 1	
Sculpture	 If you 'impress' clay you make a mark in the clay by pressing or stamping an object into it. Carving means to use tools to scrape away parts of the clay. 'Coiling' means to spiral the clay in an upward motion to form a shape.
