## Parents/Carers will try to:

- 1. Support your child in following the school rules.
- 2. Encourage good behaviour and manners.
- 3. Ensure regular and punctual attendance.
- 4. Make early contact with school when there are concerns or reasons to celebrate.
- 5. Give positive support to all staff even when times are difficult.
- 6. Attend parents' evenings and meetings to discuss your child's progress.
- 7. Ensure your child wears the correct school uniform see attached list.
- 8. Support and encourage school activities including homework and other opportunities for home learning.
- 9. Ensure all loaned books/materials are returned to school.

## School Uniform

School Uniform brings a sense of belonging and pride to the community of Crackley Bank Primary School.

Our uniform is:

- School tie (available from the school office);
- White shirt or blouse;
- Royal Blue jumper or cardigan;
- Grey skirt or trousers;
- Black shoes;
- Blue summer dresses;
- White polo shirts (during warmer weather).

Jewellery such as bracelets and necklaces are not to be worn in school. Pupils who have pierced ears are allowed to wear safety sleepers or studs but they must be removed for PE. Other piercings are strictly prohibited.

We encourage pupils to wear caps or sun hats during the warm weather. KS2 pupils are also allowed to bring sun-cream to school but must apply it themselves and must not share with other pupils. KS1 and Foundation pupils must have their sun-cream applied before they come to school.

## <u>PE Uniform</u>

Pupils need a change of clothing for PE. This should include:

- T-shirt;
- Shorts;
- Pumps or trainers;
- Track suits for winter outdoor PE;
- One piece swimming costume or trunks for swimming (not shorts or bikinis please). Parents will be notified well in advance if your child is due to have swimming lessons;
- Swimming hat for pupils with long hair.
